At KayKo Baton Studio, we enforce a dress code to ensure that all students are dressed appropriately for safety and optimal movement during class time. This uniformity also helps instructors critique choreography and fosters a sense of discipline and professionalism among students.

Twirly Tot Program (Preschool) Kinder	<p><i>Attire</i> We encourage our youngest students to wear clothes that allow them to move and feel confident. Leotards, shorts, leggings are acceptable. Hair should be out of student's face in a ponytail or braid. All hair should be up and pulled back to avoid distractions.</p> <p><i>Shoes</i> Jazz Shoes</p>
Rockets Recreational Program	<p><i>Attire</i> Form-fitting tank top. Leggings or workout shorts. (No jeans or jean shorts). Slicked bun is highly recommended. Tight ponytail or braid is acceptable.</p> <p><i>Shoes</i> Jazz Shoes</p>
North Star Competition Team	<p><i>Attire</i> Black form-fitting tank top. Black shorts or leggings. Tight, slicked bun.</p> <p><i>Shoes</i> Jazz Shoes</p>
Ballet	<p><i>Attire</i> Leotards or a form-fitting dance top. Leggings or dance shorts. Slicked bun is highly recommended. Tight ponytail is acceptable.</p> <p><i>Shoes</i> Ballet Shoes</p>

Dress Code Enforcement: Students must adhere to the dress code at all times. Non-compliance may result in student being asked to sit out of class until proper attire is worn.

The following are not-acceptable attire for any skill level:

- Jeans
- Baggy shirts, sweatshirts, or sweatpants
- Dangly or distracting jewelry, bracelets, rings
- Wearable technology
- HAIR: Hair must be pulled back tightly, out of face. A tight bun is highly encouraged.
